

Adopt-A-Street Program Policies



Prior to Adoption

- Select your potential section of city-owned street of 0.5 miles in length or longer.
- Complete Adopt-A-Street application to the Public Works/Engineering Department.

Prior to Pickup

During Pickup

- Pick up trash/litter in City of Branson's right-of-way only. Be safe and do not pick up trash/litter located on the street. Litter on private property is the responsibility of the property owner.
- The City prohibits the possession, consumption or being under the influence of alcohol or drugs while performing litter pickup within the right-of-way.
- While performing volunteer services, participants are prohibited from displaying messages, carrying banners, or other behavior that could distract drivers or adversely affect traffic.
- Contact the Branson Police Dispatch at 417-334-3300 if you encounter possible meth lab waste or other hazardous emergency conditions. Potential dangers involved while participating in this program could include but are not limited to: high speed traffic, noxious plants, broken glass, hazardous materials, sharp metal and potentially harmful wildlife.
- The group must provide adequate supervision for participants under the age of 18. Volunteers must be at least 6 years old to participate.
- Limit pick-up activities to daylight hours. Pick-up at least 3 times each year (in spring before Memorial Day, summer before Labor Day and fall before Thanksgiving).
- Securely close bags, group together and place on the curb about 4 feet from edge of the roadway.
- Park vehicles on road shoulders or parking lots when available. Do NOT park in traffic lanes.

After Pickup

- Return vests and pickers within 48 hours of pickup completion.
- Report the number of bags of trash collected, volunteers present, hours, and if your group disposed of the trash or if the City of Branson needs to pick them up. The City of Branson will:

- Approve section of street right-of-way to be adopted.
- Install and maintain volunteer recognition sign.
- Provide group volunteers with vests, pickers, and trash bags.
- Reserve the right to cancel any agreement due to failure to meet provisions of the program or safety concerns.
