

General Rules and Regulations

1. **The goal of this division is the introduction of goal keepers with the use of basic rules (handball, fouls, etc) and play restart.**
2. The time limit of each game shall be two 20-minute halves, with a 5-minute halftime. The clock will run continuous during the game, stopping only for time-outs. Teams are allowed one time-out per half; time-outs do not carry over.
3. Any rules not specifically covered in this rule set will default to FIFA/IFAB; the Recreation Specialist has the ability to modify these rules throughout the course of the season to provide for circumstances that may come up that have questionable effect on the league and game play.
4. Players who are of age 5 through age 8 on March 1st (Spring Season)/September 1st (Fall Season) are eligible to play in this division.
5. This is a 6v6 division with goal keepers (5 field players and 1 goal keeper). A maximum roster of 12 is allowed.
6. Substitutions are allowed during any and all dead balls; players must report to center field prior to being waved on by the referee.
7. Home team as determined by the schedule will start with the ball first half. Visiting team as determined by the schedule will start with the ball second half.
8. There is no offside rule.
9. There are no penalty kicks or corner kicks. Penalties inside the box are treated as indirect kicks from the spot of the foul. All corner kicks are throw-ins from the sideline. ~~Goal kicks will be treated as a keeper throw to restart play.~~ Players are allowed a second-chance throw-in if the first is illegal.
10. If a player receives a yellow-card on the field, the player must be immediately removed. The player is eligible to return to the game as a legal substitute as soon as the next dead ball.
11. There is no use of heads in this division. Use of a head results in an indirect kick for the opposing team from the spot of the infraction.
12. Slide tackling is not allowed. If a slide tackle attempt occurs, and there is no contact, an indirect kick for the opposing team may be granted if the slide interferes with the play. If there is contact, a direct kick is assessed from the spot of the infraction.

Equipment

1. A size 3 ball will be used for game play.
2. Shin guards must be worn at all times for the safety of each individual player.
3. No metal cleats are allowed.

Participation and Role of Coaches

1. Coaches are not allowed on the field, except in case of injury. All coaches should remain in the bench

area and coach from there, engaging and talking with players on the bench for encouragement and development.

2. Discussions with referees are expected to be contained to the specifics of the ruling, and should not interfere with the referee's ability to officiate.
